**Required Life Support Training for Residents/Fellows
St. Luke's Roosevelt Hospital Center**

BCLS (Basic Cardiac Life Support) is **required** for all incoming residents/fellows. **ACLS** (Advanced Cardiac Life Support) is a pre-employment requirement for many of the residency/fellowship programs. Additionally, some departments require residents to be certified in other training such as **PALS** (Pediatric Advanced Life Support) or **ATLS** (Advanced Trauma Life Support). Attached is a list of the BCLS/ACLS training required for St. Luke's Roosevelt Hospital Center's house staff. If you are entering a program that requires PALS or ATLS, please contact your program director/coordinator about registration for this additionally required training.

All incoming residents/fellows will be given the opportunity to attend the required BCLS and/or ACLS course. The training is offered by LearnACLS, LLC a private vendor contracted to SLRHC. There is no charge to the resident/fellow for this training. If an incoming house officer is currently certified in BCLS and/or ACLS, as required by their program, he/she must provide proof of such training to their program director/coordinator. If an incoming house officer is unable to get the required training prior to employment, then he/she must acquire and provide proof of the required training within two months from his/her first day of entry into the residency/fellowship program.

These programs will satisfy JCAHO, 911 Emergency Cardiac Receiving Status and the Cardiovascular Emergency Response Team member requirements for this institution.

Listed below are the Emergency Cardiac Training Programs (BCLS/ACLS) dates being offered to incoming residents and fellows at St. Luke's Roosevelt Hospital Center.
